# Welcome to Yaraandoo

Perched on the hills of Somerset, just 10 minutes west of Burnie, Yaraandoo takes its name from the Indigenous word for the Southern Cross constellation.

With sweeping views of the ocean and Table Cape, many of Yaraandoo's rooms are thoughtfully positioned to make the most of the scenery. A valued part of the Somerset community, Yaraandoo enjoys strong local connections and a vibrant sense of belonging.



## Food

Dining at Yaraandoo is varied and inclusive of all cultural, dietary and lifestyle requirements.

We offer a daily choice of menu options across three set mealtimes, as well as morning, afternoon tea and supper.

At any time during the day our residents have access to hot and cold beverages fruit and lighter snacks.

- Breakfast – Continental (cereals, porridge, fruit, toast) buffet breakfast, + one hot option daily
- Morning Tea – Fresh baked items or biscuits
- Lunch – Two-course sitting with two main course options
- Afternoon Tea – Fresh baked items or biscuits
- Dinner – Two-course sitting with one hot option + salads, sandwiches
- Supper – Fresh-cut sandwiches or biscuits

All meal options are prepared by chefs with extensive experience and a passion for creating wholesome cuisine from local ingredients, where nutrition and presentation are both paramount.

## Fees & Pricing

The cost of residential aged care can vary depending on your individual financial circumstances and the services you receive.

Residents will be asked to contribute towards their everyday living costs through a Basic Daily Fee, which helps cover meals, cleaning, laundry and other day-to-day services.

Depending on an assessment by Services Australia, some residents may also be required to pay a Means Tested Fee (or other government-assessed contribution) based on their income and assets.

Residents may also be required to pay for their accommodation. This can be paid as a Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD), a Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP), or a combination of both. Current room prices can be found on our website.

Our team can provide information about the fees that may apply and assist you in understanding the government assessment process and available payment options.
